OVERVIEW

FFLA supports any organization of grades, or grade configuration which maximizes learning and teaching, and supports the ability of schools to meet the educational needs of students.

Definitions

General Configuration

1 In this regulation “grade configuration” means the organization of a school with respect to the sequential scope of the programs in which instruction is provided to students.

Planning

The grade configuration of a school will be planned to:

- (a) provide students with access to learning environments which best meet their individual learning needs;
- (b) utilize school facilities and resources in a way which is financially responsible;
- (c) aim for class sizes that range between 24 to 28 students.

2 The principal with the board will organize FFLA classes into the following programming groups:

- (a) Kindergarten/ECS as 2.5 days per week in three annual trimesters;

- (b) Elementary as classes of Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 as five days per week in three annual trimesters;
- (c) Middle School as classes of Grades 6, 7, 8, and 9 as five days per week in three annual trimesters;
- (d) High School as classes of Grades 10, 11, and 12 as five days per weeks in semestered schedules.
